
Completed work can be submitted to the class teacher via the SeeSaw online platform. See email from school for further details regarding permissions/set up/features etc.

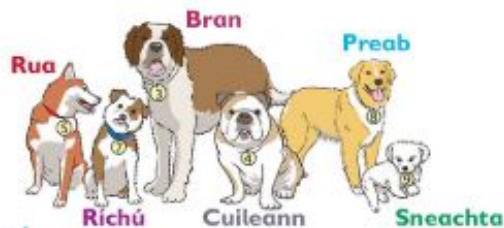
